



TRANSIT PLUS FARE INCREASE

Transit Plus will be increasing passenger fares starting **January 1, 2012**. Fares for Van and Taxi service will now cost **\$4.00 one way**, up from \$3.25.

Transit Plus provides transportation to individuals who are prevented from using the bus due to a disability. Van service is provided by First Transit and Transit Express. Taxi service is also available for riders who are able to independently board a taxi.

Since taxis are paid on a time and mileage meter, the \$4.00 fare covers any trip up to \$14.60. If the trip costs more than that, the individual is responsible for the difference. American United or American Logistics are contracted to provide taxi service.

Agency fares will increase from \$15.80 to **\$16.55 one way**.

All previously purchased tickets will be accepted as fare. Mail orders post marked by December 23, 2011 will be filled at the existing prices while quantities last. Thereafter, mail orders will be filled based on the new rates. In-person ticket orders will be sold at the new rates beginning December 27, 2011.
