The Transit Plus Advisory Council is comprised of thirteen individuals associated with the Transit Plus Program for persons with disabilities. Members are direct users of the paratransit program including parents and/or guardians of persons with disabilities who utilize the program.

TPAC has approved the following mission statement. "The Transit Plus Advisory Council mission is to serve as an advocate for persons with disabilities in liaison with Transit Plus and its contracted carriers to ensure the availability of a quality transportation system, so that such persons with disabilities may enjoy full participation in their community, work, medical care, and recreational activities. Such liaison involves relaying information, communicating, educating and advising both the providers and the community."

TPAC works diligently to ensure the availability of a quality paratransit system by relaying information, educating and advising paratransit providers and the community at large.
